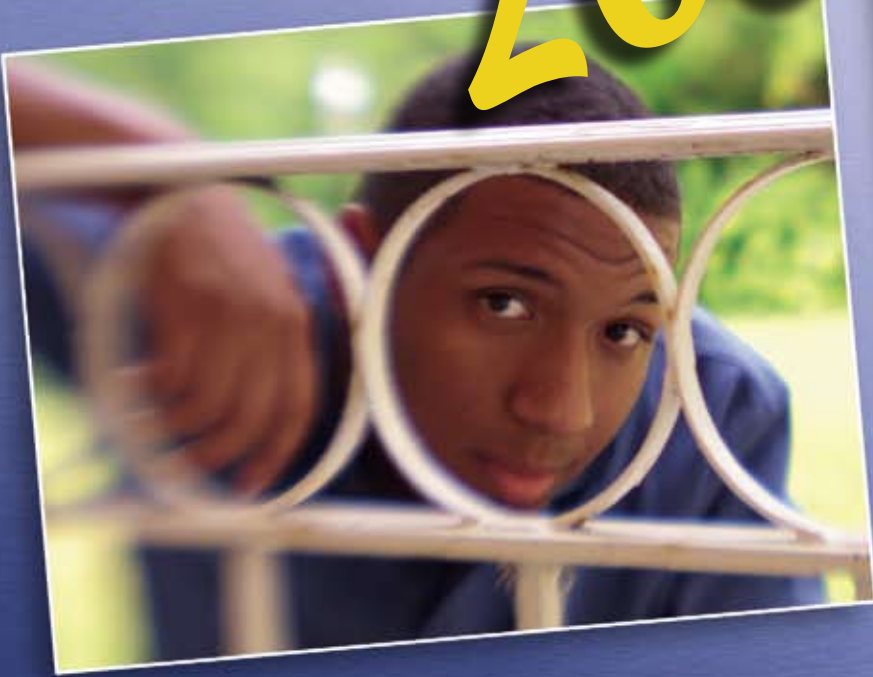
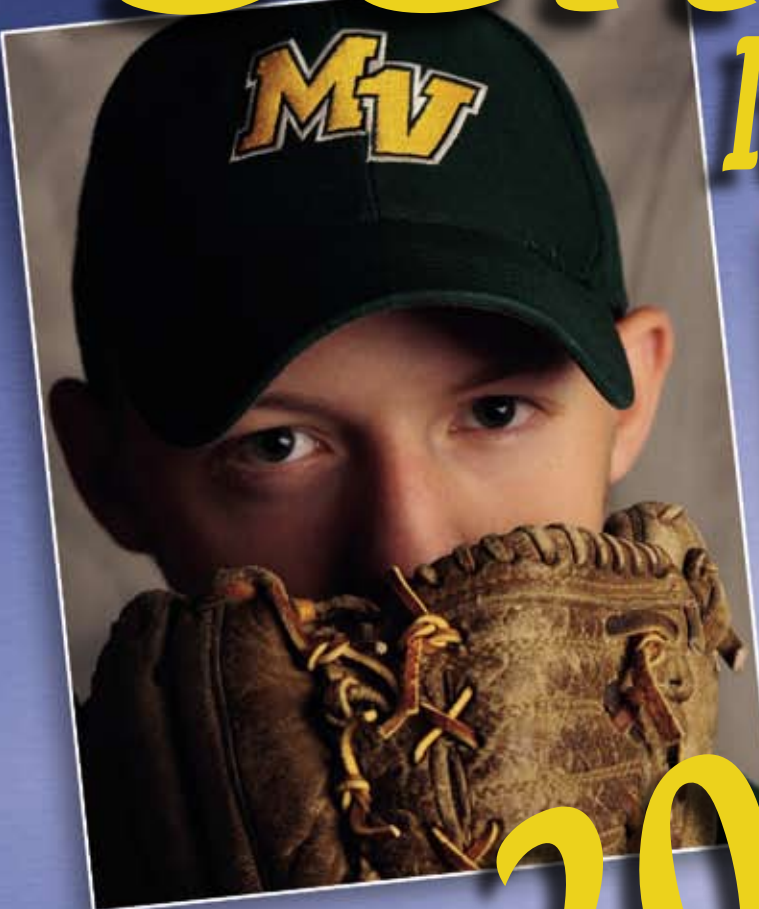

## Dear Seniors,

David Bank Studios would be happy to be your senior portrait photographer. We understand how important your portraits are to you and your family. Our studio has been taking senior portraits in the Twin Cities for over 100 years.

You've probably seen us at your school taking pictures or at dances and games. If you're in sports, music, extra curricular activities, or have been to a dance, we've already taken your photo.

You'll be hearing from a lot of studios this summer but only one is your school photographer. Don't trust just anyone with these once in a lifetime portraits. We specialize in senior portraits - it's what we do best.

First and most important we want to create a portrait that makes you look your best. We offer a variety of sessions for you to select from, with a choice of traditional and new exciting options... just make your choice.

The session fee covers the cost of photography, time, and materials to create your preview album. The session fees vary, starting at \$30.00 and are paid when you book your appointment. It just depends on how many and what kinds of images you want to choose from.

Your preview album will be ready approximately one week after your session. When you pick up your preview album a \$100.00 deposit is needed. The deposit will apply to your portrait order if you return your preview album and place your order within 30 days of deposit.

When you choose a studio for your senior portraits, pick someone you know and trust... David Bank Studios.

# TOP TEN

Questions asked about getting your senior portrait.

## #10 How do I schedule my appointment?

Yearbook deadlines are usually in September. The whole process of having your session, choosing your favorite, and getting the print to the yearbook takes 3-4 weeks. We recommend having your session in the summer. Our calendar fills up very quickly so call early to get the session you want on the day you want.

## #5 When will I see my portraits?

Your preview album will be ready for you in less than a week. From there most families and seniors take about two weeks to decide what they want for a portrait package, how many wallet size they need, and all the extras. After you place your order it will all be done in about 3-4 weeks.

## #9 What will my session be like?

It's going to be fun. You'll never have another portrait session like your senior pictures ever again. It's a big deal and we want it to be all good so we'll do our best. Bring a friend or family member along they can help or just watch. Our photographers love their jobs, they will do everything they can to make your portrait session a memorable one and your portraits great!

## #4 Can I keep my proofs?

Yes, you can purchase your preview album if you order any package in our pricelist. The packages start around \$100 you'll receive a complete pricelist with your preview album. The cost of your preview album with a package is \$100.

## #8 How do I order?

When your preview album is complete you and your family will choose your favorites at home or at the studio. You can place your order by phone, email, by mail, or in person. Doing it at the studio is always the best, we will be able to answer any questions or address any concerns you have at that time. There are absolutely no high-pressure sales!

## #3 What about "touchups"?

Don't be too concerned about bad spots. Retouching can hide blemishes, moles, smile lines, and circles under the eyes. If you have special concerns about a specific problem just ask. Remember your preview album is just the start; the best is yet to come.

## #7 What do I wear, what should I bring with?

Some sessions have multiple outfits and some just one. You're always safe to bring extras and decide at the studio. There are no "rules" about what to wear except it's got to be something you are comfortable in and you like the way it looks. Headshots look best in medium to dark tones, no strong patterns. Most seniors go for the classic formal look for the yearbook head and shoulders portrait. The props should be yours in your portrait (not a photographer's) so bring along anything you might want to take a shot with.

## #2 What if I want to order from more than one pose?

Just about everybody has more than one choice, so you're not the only ones who can't agree on a favorite. Extra poses are an additional charge of \$12 each when ordering. It covers the cost of retouching, handling, retesting, color balancing, and printing each extra image.

## #6 What will it cost, how much money do I bring?

You just need your session fee when you come in for your appointment. You won't need to bring anything until you pick up your preview album and then later when you place your order. In the end most seniors spend about \$300 on their session, preview album, portrait package, wallet size and extras.

## #1 How about retakes, if I don't like them can we try it again?

If you are not completely happy with your preview album, we want you to come back for another session. Sometimes it's hair, clothes, or expressions and sometimes it's just a bad day! Retakes are easy to schedule and shoot. They are very inexpensive and definitely worth it if you're not happy.
